

# Pollinator Garden

Annual flowers — bloom all summer, replant next year

Bring bees, butterflies, hummingbirds, and monarchs to your yard with this nectar-rich mix of **annual flowers** — plants that bloom heavily all summer and need to be replanted each spring. Plant in full sun and skip pesticides — even organic ones harm pollinators. **Tip:** Plant in groups of 3 of the same kind for impact and to help bees find them.

# Native Pollinator Patch

Perennial natives — return every year, low maintenance

Plant **perennial natives** for a low-maintenance pollinator buffet that comes back stronger every year. These Minnesota natives are adapted to our climate and need little watering once established (year 2). They feed bees, butterflies, and birds right through fall. **Tip:** Don't tidy too much — leave seed heads standing through winter to feed birds.



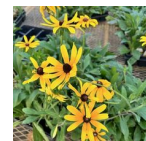

# Shade Garden

Annual flowers — bloom all summer, replant next year

Brighten up the shaded corners of your yard with these **annual flowers** that thrive in dappled or partial shade. Mix textures — broad leaves, delicate flowers, and trailing vines. **Tip:** Shade gardens dry out faster than you'd think under tree canopies — water consistently, especially the first month.



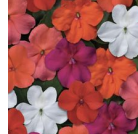

# Cutting Garden

Annual flowers — bloom all summer, replant next year

Plant these **annual flowers** in a sunny spot for fresh-cut bouquets all summer. Pinch off spent blooms to encourage more flowers (called **deadheading**). **Tip:** Cut flowers in the early morning when stems are full of water — they'll last twice as long in the vase.

# Salsa & Pizza Garden

Vegetables and herbs — annual in Minnesota

Grow your own pizza and salsa toppings. Tomatoes and peppers need at least 6 hours of sun and consistent watering — water deeply twice a week rather than a little every day. **Tip:** Pinch the tops of basil to encourage bushier growth and more leaves.

# Native Prairie Patch

Perennial natives — return every year, low maintenance

Convert a sunny spot into a low-maintenance Minnesota prairie. These **perennial natives** are adapted to our climate, attract pollinators, and need little watering once established (year 2). **Tip:** Plant in groups of 3-5 of the same species rather than singles — it looks more natural and helps pollinators find them.

# Hummingbird Haven

Annual flowers — bloom all summer, replant next year

Hummingbirds are drawn to red, orange, and pink tubular flowers. Plant these **annual flowers** together in full sun to create a refueling stop on their summer route through Minnesota. **Tip:** Hummingbirds also need water — a shallow dish or fountain nearby keeps them coming back.

# Rain Garden

Perennials — return every year, handle wet feet

Capture water from your downspouts and slow runoff with these **perennial** moisture-lovers. They tolerate temporary flooding *and* occasional dryness — perfect for low spots. **Tip:** Plant the most water-loving species at the deepest point and drier-tolerant ones toward the edges.

# Drought-Tolerant Garden

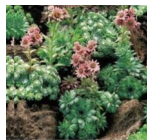
Perennials — return every year, thrive on rainfall

Skip the watering can with these **perennials** that thrive on Minnesota rainfall once established (year 2). Plant in full sun with well-drained soil. **Tip:** Add 2-3 inches of mulch to retain soil moisture and discourage weeds while plants are getting established.

# Bunny-Resistant Garden

Annual flowers — plants rabbits won't snack on

Tired of finding your flowers chewed to the ground? These **annual flowers** are unappetizing to rabbits — most have aromatic or fragrant foliage (salvia, lantana, marigold, geranium, helichrysum), fuzzy stems (ageratum), or bitter leaves (snapdragon, coleus) that bunnies avoid. **Tip:** No plant is 100% rabbit-proof — hungry bunnies will sample anything new. Protect newly planted seedlings with a 2-foot wire fence for the first 2-3 weeks until they're established.

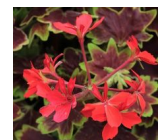

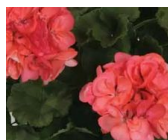

# Kid's Garden

Annual flowers + veg — fun, easy, replant next year

Get little hands in the dirt with these **annual** flowers, vegetables, and fruits. Snapdragons can be 'snapped' open like dragon mouths, polka-dot leaves are fun to point out, and cherry tomatoes are perfect for snacking right off the vine.

**Tip:** Let kids pick a few plants themselves at the sale — they'll be more invested in watering and tending them.

# Kitchen Herb Garden

Annual herbs — fresh for cooking all summer

Grow these **annual herbs** in a sunny window box, raised bed, or near the kitchen door for fresh flavor all summer.

Pinch herbs often to encourage bushiness — the more you cut, the more they grow. **Tip:** Most herbs prefer drier soil than flowers — let the top inch dry out between waterings, and skip the fertilizer (it dilutes the flavor).

# Easy Beginner's Garden

Annual flowers + veg — foolproof, replant next year

Brand new to gardening? Start with these **annual** picks (plants that bloom for one season and need to be replanted each spring). They're forgiving of irregular watering, bloom for a long season, and don't need much fuss. **Tip:** Water when the top inch of soil feels dry — stick your finger in to check; don't go by how the surface looks.

# Container Garden — Make Your Own

Annual flowers — three ready-made combos to copy or mix

Use the classic **thriller-filler-spiller** formula — one tall plant for height, one mid-size for fullness, two trailing plants to spill over the edge. Three ready-made combos below — pick one and copy it, or mix plants to make your own. **Top row** *Sunset Bowl* (warm tones, full sun); **middle row** *Garden Party* (cool / elegant, sun to part shade); **bottom row** *Shadow Box* (moody dark colors, part shade to shade). **Tip:** Containers dry out fast — water daily in summer and feed every 2 weeks.
